The Application:

The applicant is required to submit evidence of professional education including qualification documents and details of entry-level and postgraduate education, as well as the following documents: Evidence of physiotherapy qualification (with diploma) and professional experience Certificate of professional status from the regulator Documentation of applicant's name, date of birth and nationality (e.g. copies of relevant pages from passport).

Further requirements:

Slovenia does not have automatic recognition of migrants from EU countries and reserves the right to prove each applicant individually. Adaptation periods are usually arranged through the anticipated employment with theoretical education in conjunction with clinical placements and
